Non-Latino Whites are the majority in the region, representing 54% of population (See Figure 1).


Unemployment in the region has been higher than the rest of California's since 2004, with a 14% unemployment rate in 2010 (See Figure 5).

In 2010, the region lost nearly 45,000 jobs, which is the largest decline in jobs between 1996 and 2010 (See Figure 6).





























### HIGHLIGHTS
