

## Highlights:


In each age group younger than 30, the majority of the population is Latino. Asians are the majority of people in their 30's. For each age group 40 and older, Non-Latino Whites are the majority (See Figure 1).

Silicon Valley is one of the most educated regions in California, with more than 50% of Whites and Asians holding at least a Bachelorette degree (See Figure 2).







TOTAL SILICON VALLEY RESIDENTS 2,500,093



























## HIGHLIGHTS

Unemployment in the region is lower than the rest of California, with a 10% unemployment rate in 2010 (See Figure 5).

Unlike in any other region in California, Asians represent 30% of the population, in comparison to 7%, their population share in the state (See Figure 1).

Since 2003, the region lost more than 300,000 jobs. Nearly 120,000 jobs were lost in 2010 (See Figure 6).
